

spelling options

Choose any 3 options to turn in by Friday of Week 2.

All options must be completed **NEATLY** in your Spelling Spiral or in Google Classroom.

If you are unsure how to complete an option, **ASK YOUR TEACHER** for assistance before the due date.

<p>cursive words</p> <p>Practice your neatest</p> <p><i>cursive</i></p> <p>as you write your spelling words.</p>	<p>abc order</p> <p>Write all of your words neatly in alphabetical order.</p>	<p>rainbow words</p> <p>Write your words neatly using a RAINBOW of colors.</p>
<p>waterfall words</p> <p>Write your words starting with first letter on line 1. On line 2, write 1st & 2nd letter. Continue until word is spelled completely.</p> <p>Example:</p> <p>c ca cat</p>	<p>spelling city</p> <p>Type your words in "To Start, Try This! - Spelling Test".</p> <p>Choose any activity. Screen shot for proof OR write in your spiral which activity you completed and get a <u>PARENT SIGNATURE</u>.</p>	<p>spelling sort</p> <p>Find similarities in your list of words and create categories to sort your words. Your categories should be based on the SPELLING PATTERNS found in the words.</p>
<p>fancy words</p> <p>Either TYPE your words in fancy fonts (each word a different font) in a Google doc <u>OR</u> HAND WRITE your words using fancy lettering.</p>	<p>Practice test</p> <p>Have your parent call out words in random order while you write them down neatly. Include <u>PARENT SIGNATURE</u>.</p> <p><i>If you misspell any word, write 3X each.</i></p>	<p>cross words</p> <p>Pair up your words, and criss-cross them at a matching letter. Since you have an odd number of words, you may cross 3 words on the last pair.</p>

Don't forget to get a PARENT SIGNATURE for those options that require it!!
